Today most people in this country mostly drink normal, breakfast tea, a traditional that has been passed down through generations, but here at Davenports we have a huge range of "normal tasting teas" and plus quite a few different ones. Please don't worry about choosing though, our tea specialist will give you the opportunity of trying different teas, even if it is different normal tasting teas. Each afternoon tea includes one pot of tea each, which equates to 2 cups and a bit, plus you'll have the infuser for a top up. You can either have your own pot of tea or if each person on your table has different teas, you can make this afternoon tea experience even more special by tasting different teas. We offer a wide range of specialist loose leaf tea which we will brew to your own requirements using a warmed, individual china tea pot and vintage china cups and saucers.

Since 2020, we do not generally give out the menu as there are so many teas, many people are likely to be overwhelmed, so it is our pleasure to give you advice.

Northern Blend £4.50
A delicious breakfast tea best for a strong brew.

Mad Hatter Tea £4.50
A popular breakfast tea. A perfect balance of colour & flavour combined to tantalise taste buds that simply revive the spirit.

Heritage Blend £4.50
For those of you who have been visiting us for a number of years, this breakfast tea replaces our popular Kwazulu. A delicious tea with a similar taste & colour, which looks stronger than its tastes.

RAF - Royal Air Force Tea (Rare Tea Company) £4.85
A bespoke breakfast blend of breakfast tea created for the RAF by the Rare Tea Company. "To keep you calm in times of national peril and fortified when courage is required"

Assam £4.85

Darjeeling (2nd Flush) £4.85
Traditionally taken with afternoon tea, it is normal tasting and unlike breakfast tea which is blended to compliment breakfast & stronger, salty foods, this tea is blended to compliment afternoon tea. Known as the champagne of all teas, it can be served with milk or lemon, though it's delicious on its own. Forgive it for its appearance, as its not blended for colour.

Earl Grey is one tea that most people think is just one flavour....

Tregothnan Earl Grey– partly grown in Cornwall, UK £4.95

Almost 200 years after Earl Grey enjoyed this blend his descendant has created the ultimate tribute: Earl Grey made with tea grown at Tregothnan estate here in the UK and imported Assam tea and Citrus bergamia.

Staunton Earl Grey £5.00

Based on the original blend of tea given to Earl Grey himself, this Earl Grey is a unique fine black tea, blended with both Neroli (orange blossom scent) and Bergamot oils

Imperial Earl Grey £5.00

Created by a Tea Designer who also supplies some of the top hotels in London, this Earl Grey is simply stunning! Incredibly refined, black and a rare milky oolong are combined with bergamot to give a buttery, vanilla earl grey like no other.

Now things get even more interesting....

White Elixir (White Tea) £5.00

An edible beauty. This cleansing white tea is delicately blended with Jasmine petals, ginkgo leaves and spirulina. You should be tasting it as creamy, with lots of levels of flavour and green tea has proven health benefits. Some of these teas are quite rare, so are subject to availability.....

Plain green teas (but far from plain!)....

Japanese Sencha (Green Tea) £4.85

According to tea expert Jane Pettigrew, Japanese Sencha is better than Chinese Sencha. Clear, greenish liquor with a fresh, grassy flavour

Japanese Kukicha / Twig Tea (Green Tea) £4.95

A pale yellowy-green liquor, with a clean, sweet flavour.

Dragonwell (Green Tea) £5.00

A rare organic, pan roasted green tea, producing a mellow & delicate flavour with high levels of antioxidants - the King of Teas

Teas with Floral notes.....

Rose Petal £4.85

A scented breakfast tea with real rose petals. A normal tasting breakfast tea with a rose aroma.

Damask Rose Buds £5.00

Miniature rose buds sourced from the Fujian province, one of the most famous tea growing areas in China. Delicate, light, and fragrant drink that is completely caffeine free. Excellent tonic to relieve anxiety & stress.

Garden of Eden (Green Tea) £5.00

Lapsang Souchong £4.85

With a large leaf and a hefty smoky tang, this no-nonsense tea from the Fujian Province of China takes no prisoners on the taste front, but is greatly admired and enjoyed. Smoky teas tend to be enjoyed by coffee drinkers

Russian Caravan £4.85

Fine quality black tea with a trail of woodsmoke winding through it. Gets its name from the historical journey using camels to transport the tea from China to Europe, across Russia and the smokiness from being slightly contaminated by the smoke from the campfire.

Puerh Mini Cakes £5.75

An excellent introduction to puerh tea, these individually wrapped puerh cakes are from wild tea trees from Yunnan, China and exhibit a hint of smokiness with a warm apricot finish. Puerh Tea is featured in the top 10 most expensive teas in the World at No. 6. This is a raw tea is matured just like a fine wine, unlike the cooked, quicker & cheaper version.

De-Caffeinated Ceylon Caffeine Free £4.50

A normal tasting beautiful everyday yet high quality black tea that has been de-caFFEinated. From Ruhuna, Sri Lanka. To remove the caffeine, the leaves go through a simple process of being bathed in liquid CO2 – a completely natural resource, to gently extract the caffeine, leaving the authentic flavour intact

or why not choose from one of the naturally decaffeinated Rooibos

Rooibos / Red Bush Caffeine Free £4.50

Although not technically tea as it is a different plant than the camelia sinensis, has a natural sweetness with a subtle vanilla-like flavour. With a high source of zinc and packed full of antioxidants and it has great health benefits

Now for that minty taste.....

Rooibos Mint/Chocolate Caffeine Free £4.65

You must try this! This tea smells of chocolate mint, but tastes more minty than chocolaty and will compliment your afternoon tea.

Peppermint Herb Caffeine Free £4.50

Steeped in the essential oils of peppermint, this is an intensely refreshing drink.

Rare Tea – Sikkim 2nd Flush Muscatel

Grown in the Himalayan state of Sikkim (neighbouring Darjeeling), this highly fragrant black loose-leaf tea has distinctive notes of Muscatel grapes. The entire state converted to organic agriculture between 2003 - 2016 and now produces some of the purest, sustainable, and truly exquisite tea in India.

Darjeeling 1st Flush

This tea is a more exclusive Darjeeling, being the first & best pick of the season, full of nutrients after the plant has been dormant over the winter. A SFTGFOP1 (Special Fancy Tippy Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe) – a term for the leaf type. From the Thurbo Tea Estate planted in 1872, located in the Mirik Valley of Darjeeling which has an altitude ranging from 1,980 – 2,440 metres. A light, clear and bright liquor, and brisk fruity flavours.

Rare Tea – Sikkim 1st Flush

The first pick after the snow melts in the Himalayas, and the bushes start to produce their first new leaves. This loose-leaf tea is bright, clean, delicate with a highly perfumed nose.

Dao Hong Pao (Rock Oolong)

This translates to Emperor's Big Red Robe. Science allows us to offer you a taste of the most expensive tea in the World, via this clone of the mother tree, a rock oolong.

Organic Phoenix Duckshit (Oolong)

Smooth and sweet with notes of barley sugar, butterscotch and pear drops.

Peterson's Steamed (Green Tea) – Organic & home grown in Wales

Hand picked and crafted, it brews a lovely 'drink all day' cup of tea, very mellow & smooth with low astringency. Light bodied, very smooth with flavours of mixed fruit, hints of honey and the odd touch of hazelnut

Tie Guan Yin Tea/ Iron Buddha (Green Tea)

Discovered during a tea training workshop with Jane Pettigrew London Tea Master and becoming quite popular. Also refreshing as a cold brew. From Dazhai Garden Fujian, China. Notes of orchid, melon and cream. 8th most expensive tea in the World

Coffee

We do have artisan coffee; however, we would recommend talking to Belinda. She might find a tea that you like, which is more likely to give you a greater taste of your food and if you need that coffee fix, have one at the end. That's when you'd traditionally take a coffee anyway, but it is up to you.....go on, be brave!

Exquisitely ground coffee served in individual cafetières, with china mugs and a choice of hot or cold semi-skimmed milk served separately in a jug. Soya or other alternative milks are usually available, please ask at the time of ordering.

Please note due to our coffee being an artisan product some varieties may not be available.

Ethiopian Yirgacheffe (mild) £5.95
Roasted lighter to preserve its natural sweetness, this has a delicious mild taste.

Brazilian Monte Cristo (medium) £5.95
Grown under the shade of Macademia trees, it's no surprise this Central American bean has a slight nutty flavour. A divine brew that makes the perfect first light cup of the day.

De-caff. Santos (medium) £6.00
I can't believe it's not Caffeine! This beautiful Brazilian Santos has been roasted to a dark and shiny state of perfection to give all the qualities that make a great Espresso....great crema, great flavour, great body, but without the shakes!

Indian Monsoon Malabar (med/strong) £5.95
This gorgeous full-bodied coffee with an almost chocolatey aroma owes its exposure to the Monsoon winds during May and June.

Mug of Instant Coffee £3.50
If you prefer the basics, we can now offer a china mug of coffee, delicious and refreshing, please specify whether you'd like it made with hot or cold milk (or black)
